



Tēnā koutou Ngāti Pūkenga! Ngā mihi o te tau hou kia koutou katoa

I hope you all enjoyed the holiday period and had an opportunity to spend time with your whānau.

You will recall that we have been involved in both individual negotiations and Collective negotiations with the Crown since 2009. While the Ngāti Pūkenga and Tauranga Moana Iwi Collective Bills were winding their way through the legislative process last year, the Hauraki Collective continued to negotiate with the Crown.

The Hauraki negotiations finally led to the Hauraki Collective initialling the Pare Hauraki Collective Redress Deed last month, prior to Christmas. Each iwi is now being asked to approve the settlement that has been negotiated and approve the post settlement governance entities which will receive and manage the redress on behalf of the twelve iwi of Hauraki. If the iwi of Hauraki (or most of them) approve both the Deed and the post settlement governance entities, the Deed will be signed by the Hauraki iwi and the Crown.

What you are receiving is information about the Hauraki Collective settlement. Please read through this carefully so you can make an informed decision. The Hauraki Collective will be holding a number of information hui (details are contained in the Ratification Booklet) and Te Tāwharau will also be visiting each kāinga as set out below:
